Bull float man, Form setter, Liner joint setter, Top Concrete Man, Stud or Riveting Gun Man, All Scalers, Asphalt Men (all types except Screed men), Asphalt prep men, Core Driller, Core Driller Helper, Wrecking & Demolition men (Including cutting torch and burning men), Bar Man, Bar Man Helper, Salvage, stripping, wrecking and dismantling laborer. 
IMPORTANT – PLEASE NOTE
